

CFL Special Board Meeting

March 11, 2026 - 6:30 p.m.

Meeting Minutes

Attendees: CFL Trustees - Lauren Mossotti-Kline, Julie Campbell, Myron Walters, Eugene Waldbauer, Liz Cole, Glenn Reiswebber, Kristina Petrella. CFL staff members - Jessica Magelaner, Aimee Dorward, Grant Lee, Dylan Skinner. Members of the Board of the Finger Lakes Library System including Board President, Priscilla Berggren-Thomas and Executive Director, Sarah Glogowski.

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 by CFL Board of Trustees President, Lauren Mossotti-Kline
2. President Mossotti-Kline began the meeting welcoming everyone to the joint meeting of the Cortland Free Library (CFL) board and the Finger Lakes Library System (FLLS) board, for the purpose of talking through some of the questions previously posed related to the function of a library serving as the Central Library for the Library System.

President Mossotti-Kline invited all members of both board present to introduce themselves.

3. Discussion began with reviewing the document of questions generated by members of the CFL board and answered by Executive Director Sarah Glogowski. Follow-up questions were raised and addressed that helped members of the CFL board to better understand the role of the Central Library. The discussion also offered the opportunity for the CFL board to express some expectations and ideas about how a partnership might exist between both boards, should the CFL be chosen as the Central Library. CFL Director Magelaner also expressed her questions and ideas. CFL staff were also given the opportunity to share their opinion - which was favorable and enthusiastic - about the potential for the CFL to serve as the Central Library.
4. It was expressed by members of the CFL board that, if chosen to be the Central Library, it would be important for both boards to draft a Memo of Understanding (MOU) that would clearly outline the expectations and terms of the designation of Central Library. President Mossotti-Kline asked FLLS Executive Director Glogowski about the decision timeline and she shared they would like to be able to vote at their April 15 meeting. President Mossotti-Kline offered that the CFL board could vote at the March 18 meeting whether or not to express interest in being considered to serve as the Central Library with the provision of a mutually agreed upon MOU.
5. Julie Campbell made a motion to adjourn and Liz Cole provided the second. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 7:51pm
